

# Dauntsey Vale Link Scheme



The Dauntsey Vale Link Scheme ... went 'live' on Mon 19 Nov 2007. The Good Neighbour Service is available to local people from Brinkworth, Christian Malford, Dauntsey and Foxham who are in need either because they are elderly, lonely, disabled, single parents or perhaps are temporarily in need because of illness.

**The service operates** ... through a Co-ordinator via the Link telephone line on which requests for help can be made. The line is open from 10am to 6pm on weekdays and on answerphone at all other times.

**Payment** ... There is no charge but the Link Scheme appreciates any donations, which you can afford, to help cover the expense of running the scheme.

**Notice** ... Please give a minimum of 48hrs notice of a request for assistance in order that the Co-ordinator can identify a suitable volunteer. However, in an emergency the Co-ordinator will try to find a suitable volunteer to assist you.
