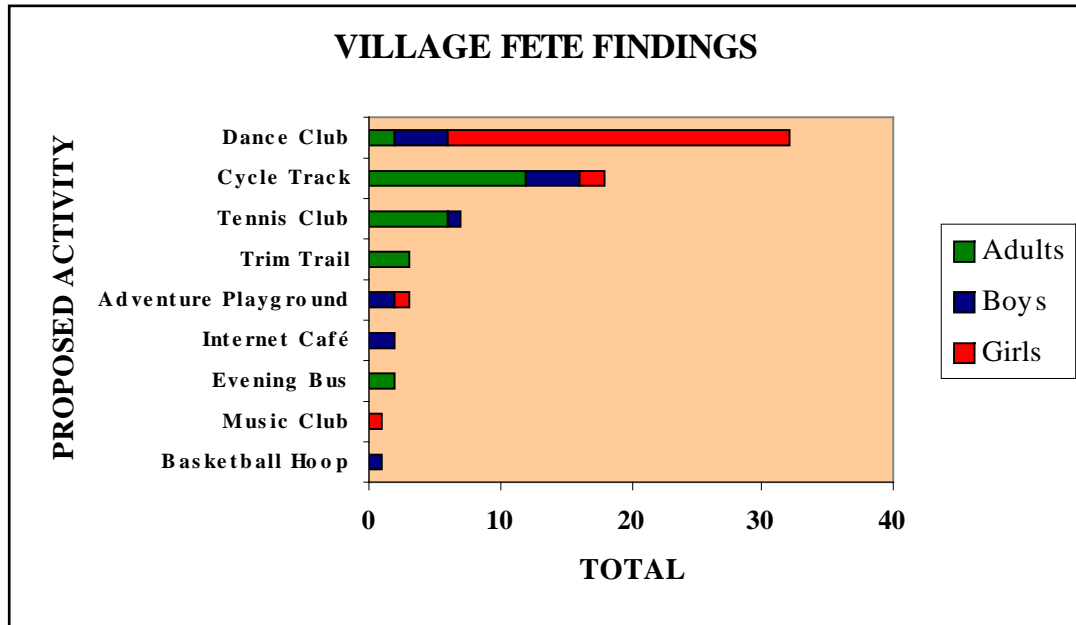


VILLAGE FETE – 10 JULY 2004
