THE ISSUES

- Restore the causeway between Christian Malford and Sutton Benger.
- Pocket Park.



THE VISION

To provide a safe environment for all the residents of Christian Malford.

ACTION

- Instigate Village 'Spring Clean' scheme.
- Curbside recycling scheme to be implemented.
- Liaise with organisations regarding footpath maintenance.
- Encourage the community to be involved in the reporting of problems.
- Investigate the possibility of a Village Project, including funding, to restore the causeway between Christian Malford and Sutton Benger.
- Investigate the viability of establishing a 'Pocket Park'.
- Produce a map of footpath walks within Christian Malford.



UPDATE

- Two dog bins have been procured and sighted at the entrance to the Rec and the junction of the Green and Station Rd.
- NWDC are extending curbside recycling across NW Wiltshire.
- Work has started in replacing footpath signs.
